



RETYRN CORPORATION - SERVICE FEE AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into between the client, and the Retyrn Corporation for the purpose of filing, negotiating, and attempting to settle any claims, or other business matters, either personal or professional, on behalf of the client. The agreement is contingent upon settlement amounts received by the Retyrn Corporation on behalf of the client.

The client hereby grants the Retyrn Corporation the authority to act: on their behalf in its efforts to settle claims but: retains sole discretion to approve or reject any claim settlement amounts in writing, prior to a final resolution. Any claim settlement: funds from third parties or insurance carriers shall be made payable to "Retyrn Corporation Trust Account" and will be distributed promptly as outlined below. Unless otherwise agreed upon.

Client agrees to provide all reasonable assistance and cooperation requested by Retyrn Corporation in support of our efforts to provide claim resolution services in a quick and efficient manner.

The Retyrn Corporations compensation for claim settlements shall be as follows:

- (a) Retyrn Corporation shall be compensated a fee of 20% of the net proceeds collected on behalf of the client.
- (b) Retyrn Corporation fees do not apply to proceeds relating to property damages for repairs or total loss valuation of the client's personal vehicle, except for monies collected over and above an initial settlement offer received by an insurance carrier. Only amounts negotiated by Retyrn Corporation which are over and above the initial settlement value for the client's property will be considered as a part of this agreement.
- (c) Any fees for collection, medical record retrieval, or legal expenses incurred by Retyrn shall be deducted prior to calculating the above stated settlement fees.
- (d) Retyrn Corporation shall provide the client with a full accounting of the final settlement details and tender all monies due to the client within 10 calendar days.
